If you are in any doubt about your ability to install this product safely you must employ the services of an competent person who has experience of fitting products of this nature.




igspace Before starting any installation project please consider the following:

- Prior to drilling into walls, check there are no hidden electrical wires or cables or water supply pipes with the aid of an electrical detector.
- If you use power tools do not forget PPE:
 - Wear eye protection.
 - Unplug equipment after use.
- Keep electrical equipment away from sources of water.
- This product must not be modified in any way as this will invalidate the guarantee.
- Basins, including the connecting water and waste system need to be installed in accordance with and meet the requirements of the water supply regulations 1999 (Water Fittings) and Scottish By-Laws 2004.
- If a blow lamp is used when plumbing, the flame must be kept away from the basins otherwise damage may occur.

INSTALLER GUIDELINES





The installation of this product greatly depends on the floor being level. If this is not the case, it must be corrected before installation.

All units should be assembled and fitted using instructions and installation guidelines provided. Any screws and other fixings used must be suitable for the installation situation. (Brick, Block, Plaster or Dot & Dab) and provide adequate support to the units when loaded.



When fitting the basin, make sure to allow enough space for worktop to fit under basin.




SEMI-RECESSED BASIN


Granley basins will secure to the wall the same way. Firstly, position the basin onto the vanity unit and in turn position the assembly in the required position against the wall.

Suitable load bearing


screws should be used to secure the basin to the wall

GOOD TO KNOW

Access to waste connections via the main door of the vanity unit.




Over tightening fittings, especially wastes can cause pressure cracks in the porcelain.

Put the vanity unit back into position and secure it to the wall, but do not fully tighten yet.

Apply a generous amount of silicone sealant to the underside section and back of the bowl that will come into contact with the wall.

Secure the bowl to the wall, again using brass screws, that are suitable load bearing and cup washers, and tighten the vanity to the wall.



CARING FOR YOUR PRODUCT



Your fitting has a high quality finish and should be treated with care to preserve the surface.

- All surface finishes will wear if not cleaned correctly.
- The only safe way to clean your product is to wipe with a soft damp cloth. Any stains can be removed using washing up liquid.
- Do not use cleaning powders or liquids.
- Even non-scratch cleaners may damage the surface of your fitting.
- Clean the porcelain immediately after use to avoid build up of residue which will be harder to remove after time.
