



Care Instructions

Do not use abrasives or solvents when cleaning this product.
Wipe off all water spillages as soon as possible using a soft, damp cloth.

Aftercare Service

In the unlikely event that this product should fail please contact HiB customer services, details shown below.

Installation:

1. Position the cabinet in the desired location. Carefully mark the position of the top of the cabinet using a soft pencil.
2. Remove the cabinet from the wall and using a spirit level, mark the position of the two mounting points (Fig. 1, Fig. 3).
3. **Before drilling, ensure there are no hidden cables or pipes behind the mounting points.** Drill the required holes in the marked positions. If drilling through tile, use a ceramic drill bit. Insert the wall plugs level with the surface of the wall. If fitting to a tiled surface, wall plugs should be inserted below the tile surface to avoid cracking. *NB. For plasterboard walls, specialist fixings should be purchased, available from any DIY or hardware store.*
4. **Lanzo & Montana Only:** Insert the hook screws into the wall plugs.
5. **Lanzo & Montana Only:** Hang the cabinet on the wall ensuring that it is firmly located on both hook screws. Adjust the bottom screw (Fig. 2 - A) to level the cabinet. Fix the cabinet to the wall firmly by tightening the front screw (Fig. 2 - B).
6. **Turin only:** Fix cabinet to wall by attaching fittings through the back faces of the cabinet (Fig. 3).
7. **Turin only:** Fit screw cover caps.
8. The hinge can be adjusted in order to reposition the door correctly. See Fig. 4 for further information.
