

Bathroom Accessory & Fitting Care Instructions.

IMPORTANT: Please read these instructions before starting work.

1. Check that there are no buried pipes or cables before drilling any holes. Take extreme care when using electrical equipment near water.
2. Do not fit accessories onto newly papered or painted surfaces as chemical reactions could cause discolouration to the products. (Please refer to manufactures instructions).
3. We recommend the use of a specialist drill bit when fixing accessories to a tiled area.

Supplied Fittings: Screws ,wall plugs , fitting posts & hexagonal key (range dependant).

Fitting Instructions.

1. Establish position for the accessory, making sure there is sufficient room.
2. Items must always be measured prior to fitting, as there will be slight variations in production runs.
3. Drill holes with a 5.5mm masonry drill & insert the wall plugs so that they are flush with the wall. Note the wall plugs provided are suitable for solid walls only. If using on plasterboard or hollow walls, specialist fixings are required, these can be obtained from a DIY outlet.

Range –specific methods:

1. Heritage - Chrome or gold plated screws put directly through the base plate.
2. Shaker & Sonic – Concealed fitting plate. Mark out the position of the plates and screw to the wall. Attach accessory to plates and screw with grub screw.
3. Unity & Portiique – Fitting post. Mark out position of posts and screw to the wall. Slide base plate and collar onto post, followed by the accessory. Secure the grub screw.



Before starting any installation project please consider the following:
Prior to drilling into walls, check there are no hidden electrical wires or cables or water supply pipes with the aid of an electrical detector.
If you use power tools do not forget:

- Wear eye protection
- Unplug equipment after use

Aftercare Instructions.

Your fitting has a high quality finish and should be treated with care to preserve the visible surfaces. All surface finishes will wear if not cleaned correctly, the only safe way to clean your product, is to wipe with a soft damp cloth. Stains can be removed using washing up liquid. All bath cleaning powders and liquids can damage the surface of your fitting even the non-scratch cleaners.

All products are manufactured to the highest standards and a 10-year guarantee covers any defect in manufacture.
