

Basin Mixer Installation Guide

Step 1 – Insert metal spigots into tap

Step 2 – Insert flexi tails into the tap. Only hand tighten. Do not let the flexi tails coil. Do not loop them. Do not over tighten.

Step 3 – Place the tap on the basin. Make sure the baseplate and 'o'ring are situated correctly to seal around the tap hole.

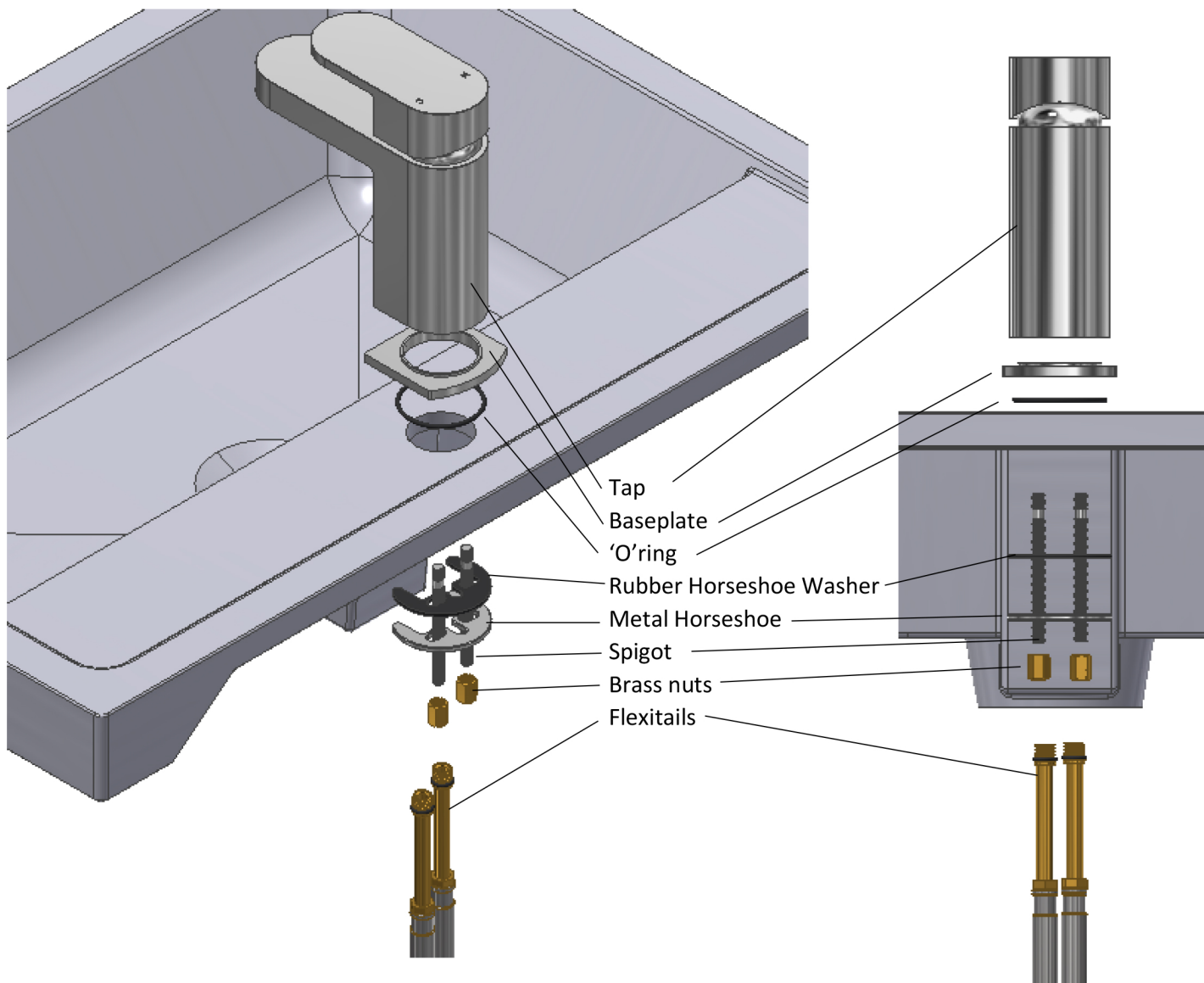
Step 4 – On the underside of the basin place the rubber horseshoe, metal horseshoe then the brass nuts on to the spigots.

Step 5 – Tighten the brass nuts using an appropriate box spanner or adjustable spanner.

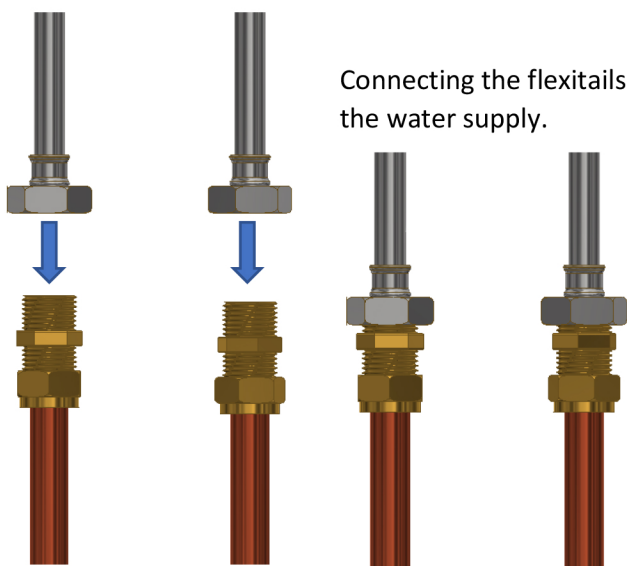
Step 6 – Connect hot feed to hot tail and tighten using spanners.

Step 7 - Do the same for the cold side (the tap from front on - cold is right, hot is left.)

Step 8 - Turn the water on to test for leaks.

Customer Care Guide

To clean your tap use water or soapy water only. Do not use abrasive cleaners.

Do not allow limescale to build up in hard water areas

Do not use abrasive products on any surfaces
