


Flush Plate for Concealed Cisterns

Before you Begin:

- This instruction shows how to fit the flush plate. Ensure the part is the correct size and fit in conjunction with your chosen compatible concealed cistern.
- Unpack the product then read these instructions before proceeding. Inspect the product for damage. If any damage is found, contact our Customer Relations team.


Bolts (x2)

Fixing Plate

Note: Diagrams are for illustration purposes only. Your Flush Plate may superficially differ from this drawing however the installation guide steps still apply.



Connect the 'Fixing Plate' to the plastic frame. Ensure the plate is fully clipped into place.





Recycling and Disposal:

 Please recycle the packaging in accordance with your local government regulations on waste handling and follow the same advice at the end of the products life.



Secure the 'Fixing Plate' into place using the 'Bolts' provided.


Connect the vacuum pipes from the flush valve, to the appropriate fixings on the rear side of the 'Flush Plate'.


Note: Ensure the pipes are aligned to the correct flush button.



Align the 'Flush Plate' with the plate frame. Once aligned, press inwards until the 'Flush Plate' is fully inserted into place.

Note: To disassemble; insert a flat-head screwdriver into the side of the 'Flush Plate' and carefully pull it outwards.





Cleaning and Aftercare:

Warning: Do not use abrasives, scourers, bleach or any type of chemical cleaning solution when cleaning the overflow cover. It is recommended to use warm soapy water and a clean damp cloth.
