


Undermount Sink


Please follow these care instructions to ensure your product retains it's high quality finish and please retain this leaflet for future reference.

Step 1: Countertop Cutout

Cut out the template provided and place onto the work surface.


Using a pencil draw around the outer edge of the template.

Using an appropriate Jig Saw cut along the pencil lines.




Step 2: Align and Mark Fixing holes

Following the diagram below Align and mark the underside of the countertop with a pencil for the fixings/clips to be attached. Then using an appropriately sized drill bit ($\varnothing 10$ mm), drill to a depth of 15mm.




Step 3: Install Fixings/Clips

Using the holes from Step 2, install the fixings/clips as shown



Step 4: Apply Adhesive

Apply a bead of epoxy or silicone adhesive around the top edge of the sink cut-out on the underside of the countertop. This adhesive will help bond the sink to the countertop and create a watertight seal.



Step 5: Install the Kitchen Sink

Once the sink is in place, use clamps to hold it firmly against the underside of the countertop. If you have sink clips or brackets, use a screwdriver or adjustable wrench to tighten them, securing the sink to the countertop. Be cautious not to overtighten, as it could damage the sink or countertop.
