

Installation


Step 1: Template & Preparation

- Place the basin in the desired location on the work surface and using a pencil, mark around the outer edge of the basin and waste hole.
- Cut out the work surface along the pencil lines using an appropriate saw/ jigsaw.




Step 2: Install Sink Stainer

• Connect the pieces of the sink strainer. Proceed to fit the sink strainer to the basin.




Step 3: Sink Installation

- Carefully apply a bead of good quality silicone sealant along the edge of the cut work surface.
- Place the basin into position and press down gently to ensure a secure fit.
- Finally, pipe a fine bead around the outer edge of the sink edge using a good quality silicone sealant in either a colour match or clear finish.
- Remove any excess silicone with a damp cloth. Let the silicone dry for 24 hours.



Step 4: Connect the Waste Pipework

• Install the waste pipe and connect to the finished basin. Refer to the installation instructions for guidance.



Maintenance:

We recommend that you regularly clean your sink with a soft cloth and warm soapy water. Rinse and dry after cleaning, this is extremely important for areas with hard water. Refrain from using acidic household cleaners, wipes with harsh chemicals, or abrasives, as these will damage the sink.
