

Thank you for purchasing this Victorian Plumbing product. Please follow these care instructions to ensure your lightpull retains its high quality finish - and retainthis leaflet for future reference.

#### **WARNING**

Always ensure that the mains power to the pull switch is turned off beforeremoving the pull switch cover to replace the cord of a light pull.

If in doubt please consult a qualified electrician.

### Fixing Instructions for Lightpulls which consist of two separate pieces:

1. Unscrew the bottom section of the light pull. Push the cord through the top piece of the light pull, out of the bottom and tie a knot in the end. Pull the cord from the top of the light pull until the knot is held securely inside. Screwthe two sections of the light pull back together.

# Fixing Instructions for Lightpulls which consist of one single piece:

 Insert the cord through the small hole at the top of the light pull. Push the cord all the way through the light pull, out of the bottom and tie a doubleknot in the end. Pull the cord from the top of the light pull until the knot is held securely inside.

Please note that a swinging light pull may cause damage to any nearby surfaces.

## **Product Care**

To retain the best quality finish, clean product regularly with a soft cloth and mild detergents. Do not use abrasive or chemical cleaners as these will damage the product.
