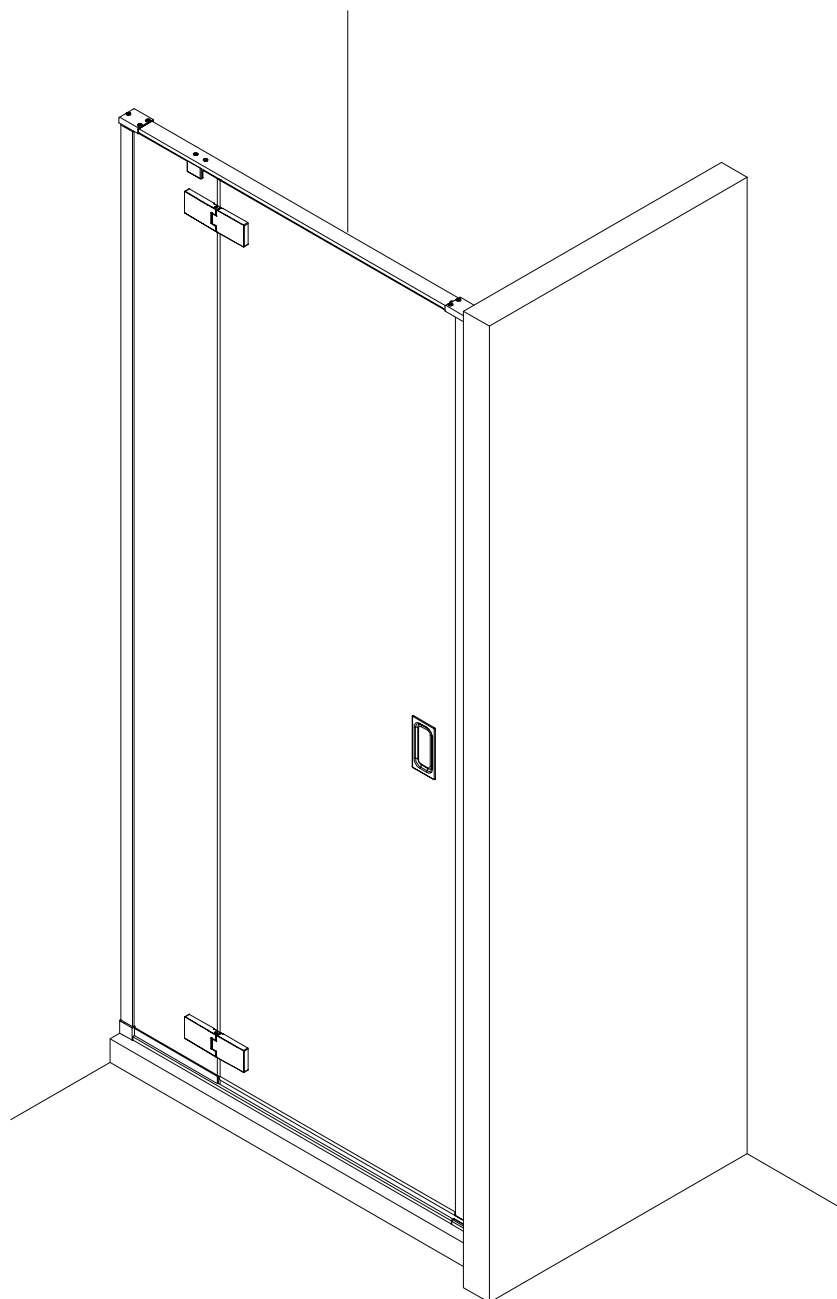

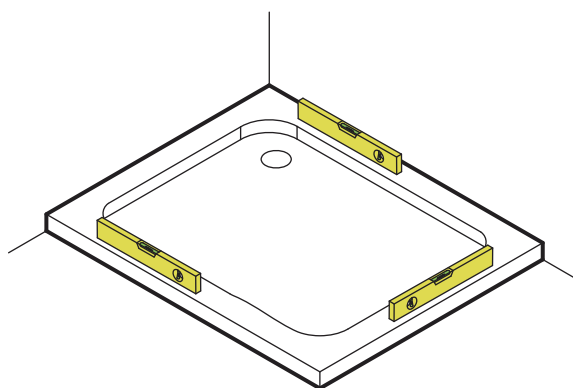
1. Full details are supplied to the manufacturer;

3. The manufacturer is informed of any damage/shortages prior to installation.

The success of the installation and operation of any shower enclosure is, of course, dependant on the squareness, alignment and construction of the walls to which fixing is to be carried out.

VERY IMPORTANT

You must complete all tiling and grouting, and the shower tray **MUST** be level and fully sealed to the tiles before installation. If you do not fit the enclosure onto a tiled surface, or seal the tiles to the tray before installation, water may soak into the wall behind the wall profiles.



INSTALLATION - Advice and safety

The installation instructions are based on typical use and conditions.

These products come with the two wall channels pushed onto each side of the glass panel frame.

These hints have been prepared for your guidance, you must exercise due care at all times.

For Health and Safety 2 people must carry out the installation of this enclosure.

Handle glass with care. Although the glass supplied is toughened safety glass (EN12150), impacts can damage both the glass and the frame.

Warning!

Please check for any hidden pipes or cables before drilling holes in the wall.

To stop the drill bit slipping, masking tape can be applied to the tiles when preparing the holes.

When using power tools always follow the manufacturers user instructions.

Do not sit the enclosure on a bed of silicone, as this will also stop any water from draining back into the tray.

If the enclosure is sealed to the tray on the inside, any water that may get into the framework will not be able to drain back into the tray, this may cause the enclosure to leak.

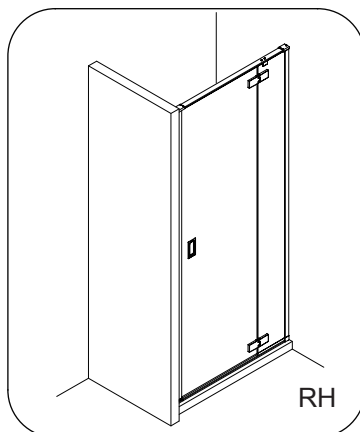
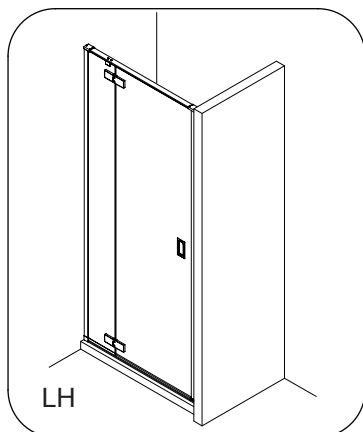

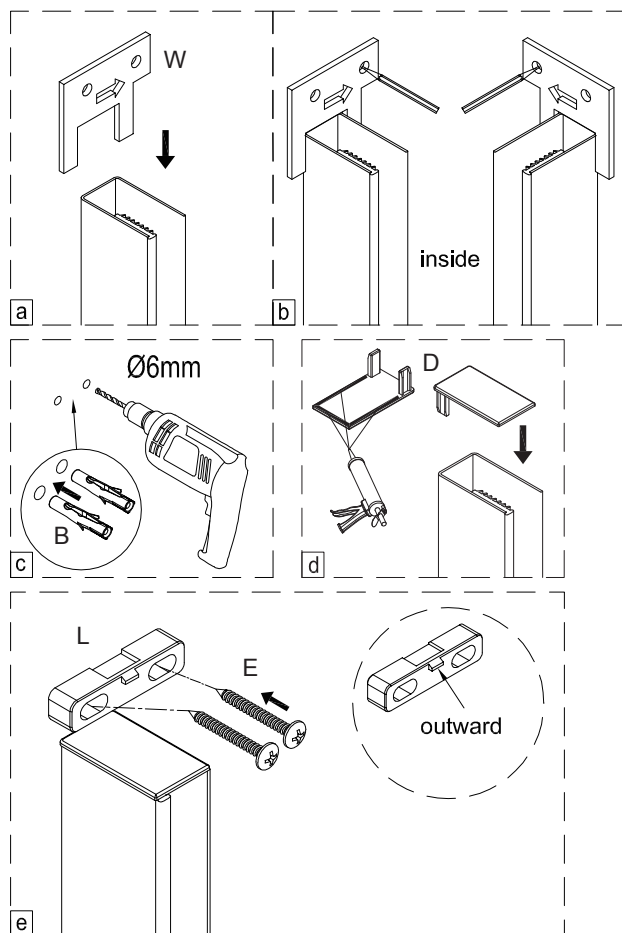

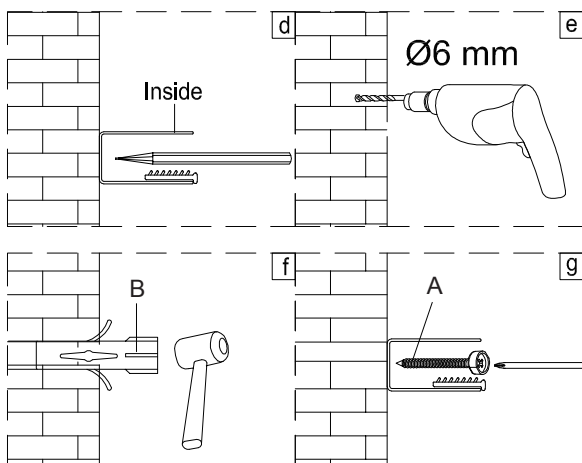

Tools and equipment needed

Drill, 6mm Masonry drill bit, Cross Philips screwdriver, Slotted Philips screwdriver, Spirit level, Pencil, Tape measure, Knife, Silicone sealant, Wood,Rubber Mallet.

Figure 1 illustrates the assembly sequence of the wall frame. (a) shows the initial assembly of the wall frame with components T and O. (b) shows the assembly of the wall frame with components P and Q. (c) shows the assembly of the wall frame with components P and Q.



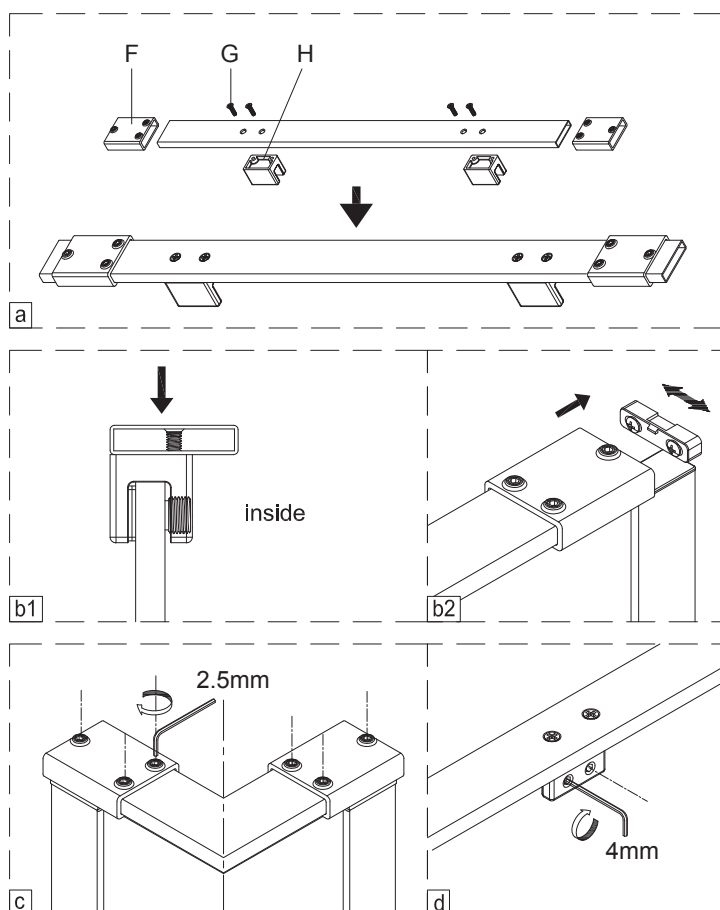
The diagram illustrates the correct and incorrect methods for installing a double-sided adhesive tape on a glass panel. It is divided into three main sections: (a), (b), and (c).

Section (a): Shows the correct method for applying the adhesive tape. The tape is applied to the inside of the glass panel. The label "Inside" is used to indicate the correct side. The label "water" is used to indicate the correct application of the adhesive. The label "C" is used to indicate the correct application of the adhesive.

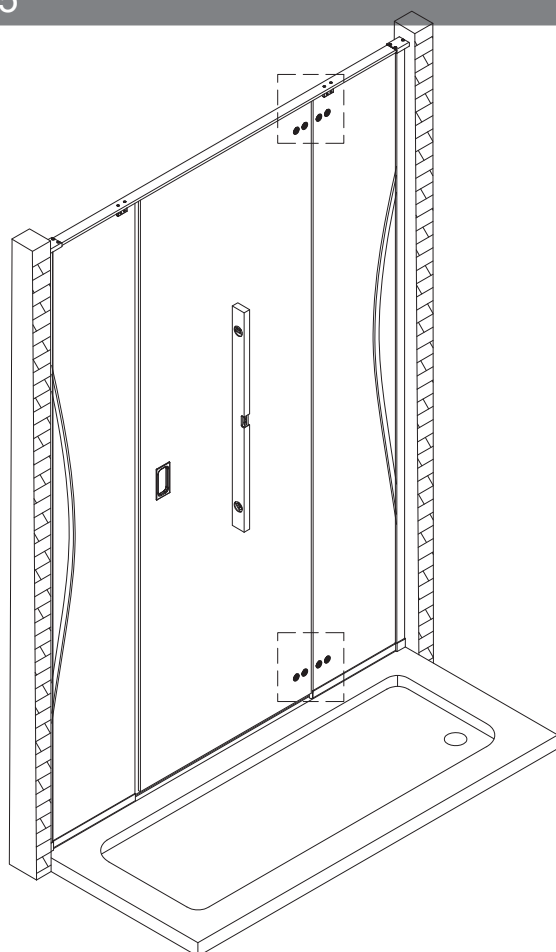
Section (b): Shows the correct method for cleaning the glass. The label "alcohol prep pad" is used to indicate the correct cleaning method. The label "Clean the glass with alcohol prep pad ." is used to indicate the correct cleaning method.

Section (c): Shows the correct method for tearing the double-sided tape. The label "S" is used to indicate the correct tearing method. The label "Tear the double-side tap and install at the same time." is used to indicate the correct tearing method.

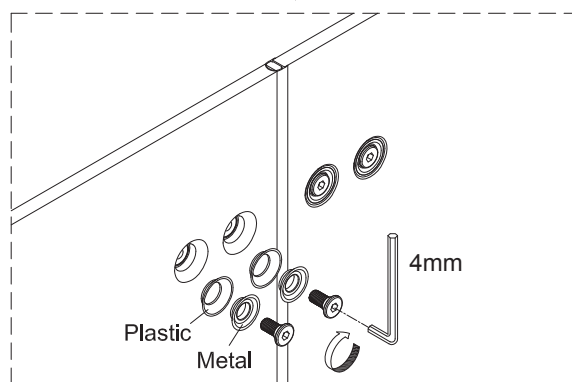
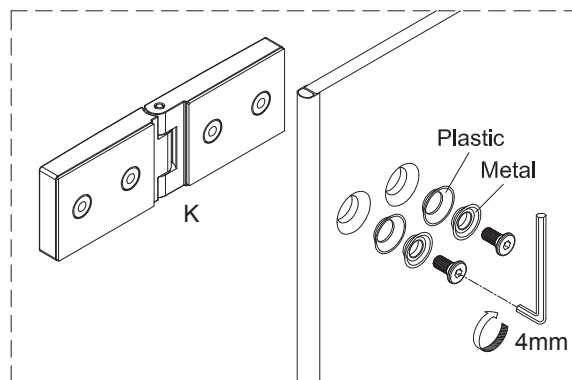
Section (d): Shows the correct method for installing the glass panel. The label "inside" is used to indicate the correct side. The label "X" is used to indicate the incorrect method. The label "✓" is used to indicate the correct method.



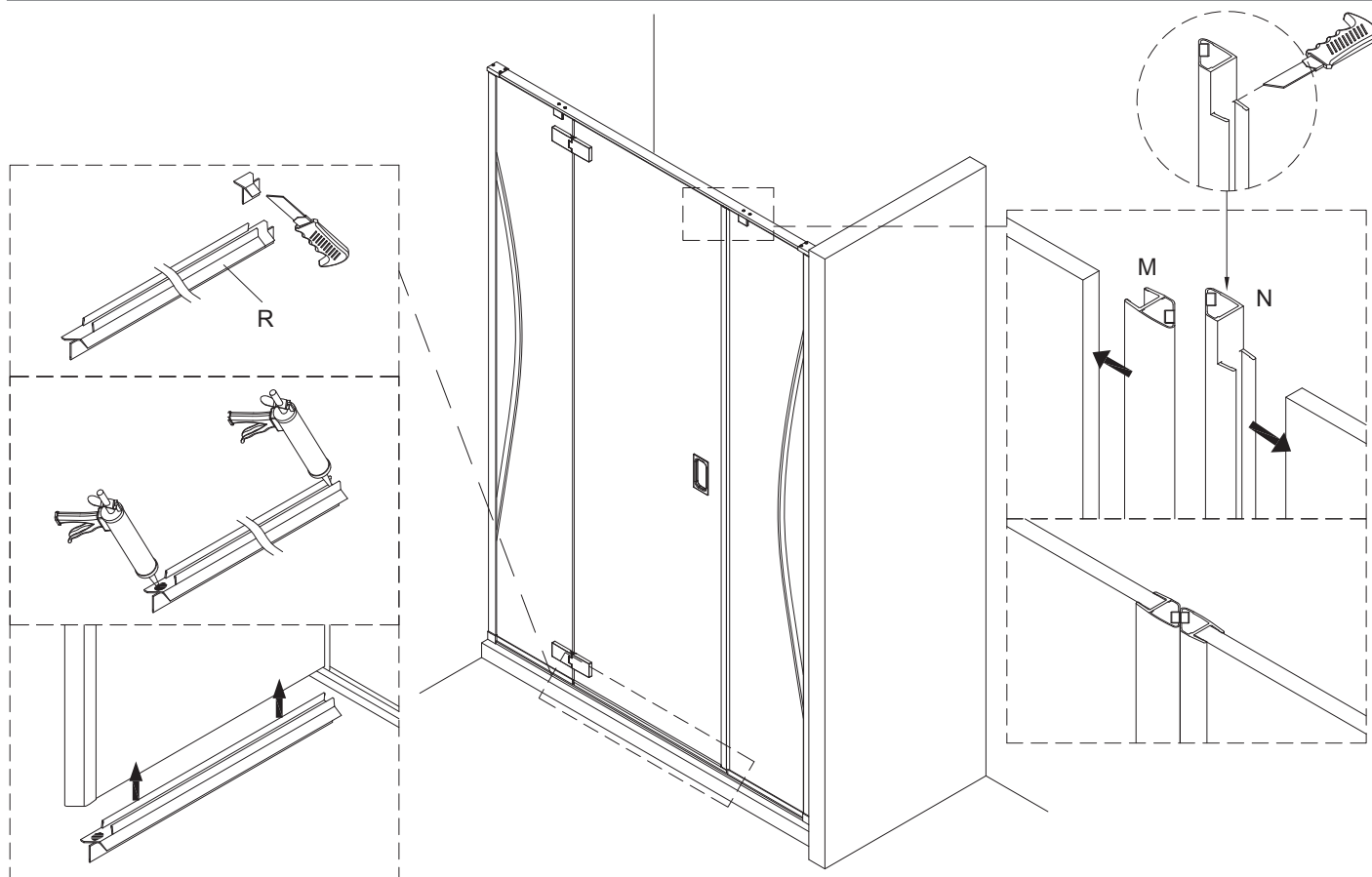
