


Bottom Fixing Toilet Seat Installation Instructions

Before you Begin:

- This instruction shows how to fit the toilet seat. Ensure the toilet seat is the correct size in conjunction with your toilet pan.
- Unpack the product then read these instructions before proceeding. Inspect the product for damage. If any damage is found, contact our Customer Relations team.




Make sure that all components are present prior to installation.









- 1. Toilet Seat with Hinge Plates
- 2. Threaded rods (x2)
- 3. Locking Washers (x2)
- 4. Hinge Plates (x2)
- 5. Rubber Washers (x2)


Note: Diagrams are for illustration purposes only. Your toilet seat may superficially differ from this drawing however the installation guide steps still apply.


Cleaning and Aftercare:

- **Warning:** Do not use abrasives, scourers, bleach or any type of chemical cleaning solution containing bleach when cleaning the toilet seat. It is recommended to use warm soapy water and a clean damp cloth.
- If you use bleaches and strong cleaning solution in the pan. **DO NOT** leave the seat closed as the fumes from the bleachers and cleaners may damage the finish on the seat.
- **Tighten the nuts regularly:** Check the nuts that connect the seat to the toilet bowl every few months and tighten them if necessary.
- Avoid Standing on the lid or toilet seat: Standing on the seat can put unnecessary stress on the bolts and hinges and may damage the seat.



Place the rubber washers over the hinge plates, then screw the threaded rods into the hinge plate holes on the toilet seat.






Place the toilet seat over the pan with the threaded rods fed through the fixing holes in the pan.



On the underside of the Pan, place the locking washer and locking nut over the threaded rods and tighten to secure into place.

Note: Before fully tightening the locking nut; adjust the toilet seat to fit the pan, then tighten the nuts.
