

Installation Guide

Before you begin:

1. **Remember, safety should always be a priority** when installing any large piece of furniture or decor. If you have any concerns or doubts about the installation process, it's best to consult a professional for assistance.

2. **Keep children and pets in mind:** If you have young children or pets, make sure the leaning mirror is secured in a way that prevents them from accidentally knocking it over. Consider placing it in an area where it's less accessible to them.

3. **Unpack the product then read these instructions before proceeding.** And Inspect the mirror for damage. If any damage is found, contact our Customer Relations team.

Installation:

1. **Choose a stable location:** Find a spot in your home that provides a stable and level surface for the mirror to lean against. Avoid placing it near high traffic areas or areas where it could easily be bumped or knocked over.

3. Use a wall anchor: If you're leaning the mirror against a wall, consider using a wall bracket to secure it in place. This will prevent the mirror from sliding or falling forward. Consult the manual on INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR NON-LIGHTED MIRRORS.

4. **Check the weight capacity:** Make sure to check the weight capacity of the leaning mirror and ensure that the surface you're placing it on can support its weight. If needed, reinforce the surface or seek professional advice for installation.

5. **Regularly check for stability:** Periodically check the stability of the leaning mirror to ensure it hasn't shifted or become loose. Tighten any brackets or anchors as needed.
