


L-Shaped Front Bath Panel



Fitting Instructions

Please follow them carefully and leave this manual with end user

Before you begin:

- We recommend that this product is installed by a qualified tradesperson, Victorian
 Plumbing Ltd. accept no liability for products incorrectly installed or any damage to the
 floor, walls, plumbing, panels, bath, or personal injury during installation.
- 2. Observe all local plumbing and building codes & regulations.
- 3. It is recommended to build a frame or battens along the floor, set these the required distance so the panel sits flush and level.
- 4. Ensure the incoming mains water supply is switched off prior to commencing the installation.
- For the following instruction, its assumed that the bath is pre-installed and working correctly.
- 6. Unpack the product then read these instructions before proceeding. Inspect the product for damage. If any damage is found, contact our Customer Relations team.



Installation:

Diagrams are for illustration purposes only. Your bath panel may superficially differ from this drawing however the installation guide steps still apply.


Step 1:

Hold the short ($\bf A$) and long ($\bf B$) panels together (making sure the short panel sits on top of the long panel). Place and mark the L-shaped brackets ($\bf C$) onto the panels prior to securing the panels ($\bf A + \bf B$) together.




Step 2:

Secure the brackets in place, using the screws provided (**D**) through the L-shaped bracket holes and into the pre-marked holes. Using a spirit level, ensure the panels are level both vertically and horizontally.




Step 3:

Repeat this process for the other panel (making sure the long panel sits on top of the short panel). Screw the L-Shaped brackets on the outside corner, ensuring the panels are level.




Step 4:

Place the panel strip (**E**) within the inner corner (front facing) of the panel. Mark the positions at the back of the panel and using the long screws (**F**), secure the panel strip into place.



Step 5:

Secure the panel to the timber frame or batten by either using good quality sealant or traditional screw method. Apply a bead of good quality silicone sealant across the bottom of the panel to prevent water ingress.



Step 6:

Wipe away excess silicone with a damp cloth and allow 24 hours for the sealant to fully dry.



Cleaning and Maintenance:

We recommend that you regularly clean your panel with a mild dish detergent. After each use, wipe the panel dry with a soft cloth. Refrain from using acidic household cleaners, wipes with harsh chemicals, or abrasives, as these will damage the panel.

Recycling and Disposal:

Please recycle the packaging in accordance with your local government regulations on waste handling and follow the same advice at the end of the products life.
